ELHAP is a registered charity and a company limited by guarantee. ELHAP offers adventure play opportunities to children and young people with disabilities through school visits, holiday playschemes and Saturday to the local community. ELHAP also runs a small Day Service for young adults with disabilities throughout the year, a Transition Project for disabled young people, a Sleep Over Project for young people and a Volunteer Project.
