What is the Transition Project?

The ELHAP Transition Project is for disabled young people, who are moving on from children's services. The ELHAP Transition Project is a springboard, giving young people the opportunities and experiences to decide what they want to do with their lives. At the end of the Project, young people will be able to make informed decisions about their future including jobs, study, interests, hobbies and friendships. The Transition Project is community based and normally runs on two days of each week, 9.30am – 3.30pm each day.

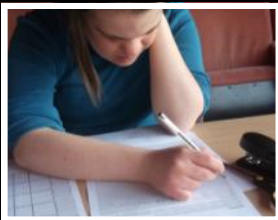
