ELHAP is an adventure playground for children, young people and adults with disabilities or additional needs.

More than 5300 children and young people visit ELHAP each year.

## ELHAP's aims are:

- To offer free play opportunities to children and young people with disabilities and special needs
- To provide a place for children and young people to explore, experiment and enjoy themselves in an atmosphere of fun, challenge and opportunity.
- To assist children and young people to gain self-confidence, self-fulfilment and independence through play.
